

H.O.P.E. Behavior Policy 2022-2023

Because we are NOT a school, we are not equipped to handle ongoing discipline issues. We expect you, the student, to be respectful and considerate of our teachers, the parent on duty (including any committee members), the church facilities and staff, and other students. Attendance at H.O.P.E. is a privilege and so any disregard of the following policies could lead to dismissal from co-op.

Therefore, I agree to the policies listed below which include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. I will keep the noise levels to a minimum during classes. If a teacher or parent on duty asks me to quiet down or leave an area, I will do so immediately and in a respectful manner.
2. If I make or am involved in making a mess, I will take responsibility and clean it up. If I see a mess, I will clean it up myself or help the student(s) who made it.
3. If I am asked to help clean up or tidy up by a teacher or parent on duty, I will acknowledge them and finish the job as they ask all the while maintaining a respectful and cheerful outlook.
4. I will respect all property of Windsong Church and H.O.P.E. by treating it better than my own property.
5. I will remember that chairs or the floor are the only acceptable surfaces for sitting on and that tables and countertops do not fall in this category.
6. I will take responsibility for any damage I inflict or even accidentally cause to any and all property both inside and outside which belongs to Windsong, H.O.P.E., or any other students or teachers. I will own up to it and my family, and I may be asked to make financial reparations.
7. I will respect any boundaries due to construction at Windsong church.
8. I will drive safely and slowly in the parking lot. (The speed limit is 15 mph.) This includes never riding on the outside of any vehicle or allowing others to do so.
9. I agree to refrain from any public displays of affection between myself and another student of the opposite sex.
10. In all my interactions with other students, teachers, parents on duty, and any Windsong Church staff I will consider them with utmost respect in both my words and actions.
11. If I should require a covid test for any reason during the year, I will not return to the classroom until I have received negative test results. If I have positive test results, I will not return to class until I have fulfilled the proper quarantine time assigned by a doctor.
12. If I am feeling sick or have a fever, I will stay home from class or leave the premises promptly, whichever situation applies.

We have a wonderful H.O.P.E. community and have faith that you will conduct yourself well. However, if a policy isn't followed, you will be asked to sign a copy of this form. The frequency or degree of infraction and your response may lead to you being asked to seek an alternative to H.O.P.E.
